# **Questions to Ask on College Visits**

## ADMISSIONS OFFICE

- 1. What makes your university unique?
- 2. What are your retention rates?
- 3. What is the principal reasons students leave or transfer out?
- 4. What are your 4, 5, and 6-year graduation rates?
- 5. What is the percentage of students who, after graduation, go to work, go to graduate school, do something else? What else are they doing?
- 6. How important is demonstrated interest/college visit to your admissions process?
- 7. Do you conduct a holistic review of each application? If so, what are things you take into consideration outside of just the GPA and test scores? What separate applications are required for additional scholarships?
- 8. Do you recommend an interview?
- 9. Do you recalculate GPA, and if so, how? Under the recalculated scale, what kinds of GPAs generally get admitted to the college?
- 10. Do you look at class rank?
- 11. Would I have been accepted last year?

## FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

- 1. What kind of financial assistance does the college offer: need-based, merit-based, or both?
- 2. What is the average student loan indebtedness of the college's graduates?
- 3. What types of academic/talent scholarships are available?
- 4. What will the rate of increase of the tuition will be over the 4 years? Will the the scholarships you offer increase at the same rate?
- 5. If I receive any outside scholarships (not from the university), does this affect my financial aid package?
- 6. What kinds of work-study jobs are available?

- 7. Is study abroad included in costs regardless of where we go? Will my financial aid cover all those costs?
- 8. Can the college provide an early estimate of what our financial aid award might be?
- 9. What forms are needed in order to apply?
- 10. When are financial aid applications due?
- 11. What costs for a student are taken into account by the financial aid office? Tuition, room, board, transportation? How about additional expenses like books, fees, computers and personal expenses?
- 12. What is included in the comprehensive fee? For example, do students have to pay extra for computer time or to attend campus events (concerts, plays, films, lectures, athletic events, etc.)?
- 13. When will we be notified about the amount of assistance we can expect?
- 14. Does the institution have an appeal process to review special circumstances?
- 15. Is there a commitment for financial assistance beyond the first year?
- 16. How and when do we apply for financial assistance after the first year?
- 17. What if we do not qualify for need-based aid? Are there alternative financing options available?
- 18. What grants, loans and work study opportunities are offered by the college itself?

  Are there any we might be eligible for?
- 19. Is there a restriction to the length of time that financial assistance will continue?
- 20. What happens if our family's financial situation changes substantially during the school year?
- 21. Are there any payment options available (such as monthly or quarterly)?

#### CAREER CENTER

- 1. Can you give me examples of how faculty go above and beyond to help students with career advising?
- 2. What resources are available to undergraduates in terms of a career center, internship opportunities, networking events, etc.? Do separate departments have

- their own process or does the university as a whole have a career center that all students have access to?
- 3. What percentage of your graduates are employed in their field after graduation? What is your sample size?
- 4. Where are graduates from your university employed?

## ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND DEPARTMENTS

- 1. What are your most popular/distinguished programs?
- 2. Is there a core curriculum? If so, what are the distribution requirements?
- 3. How many students will be in my first year courses and introductory courses?
- 4. What is the quality and ranking of the academic programs at the college? What do the reviews say? What do students say?
- 5. What makes \_\_\_ major stand out?
- 6. What are some interesting/exciting things that students are doing with a major in ?
- 7. What can you tell me about the accreditation of your programs?
- 8. Do undergraduates have access to research with faculty members for their my program? What does that timeline look like for those students?
- 9. Is there a separate application process to be admitted into the program of my choice? Or, am I automatically admitted into my major of interest when I am admitted into the university?
- 10. If I decide to switch my major, what does that look like? Is there an application process in order to get into a different program as a current student?
- 11. What percentage of classes are taught by faculty members and what percentage are taught by TAs?
- 12. Do students have a full-time faculty advisor, a staff advisor, or both? Are students required to meet with their advisor before signing up for academic classes?
- 13. To what extent do undergraduates participate in faculty research?
- 14. Is there an Honors Program? If so, what does it consist of?

- 15. What does it take to graduate in 4 years?
- 16. Is is possible to study abroad for a full semester or full year and still graduate in 4 years?
- 17. How many students study abroad?

## ADVANCED DEGREES

- 1. What is the professional exam pass rate?
- 2. What graduate schools do alumni pursue?
- 3. What are your acceptance rates for med school, law school, grad school?

## CAMPUS LIFE AND HOUSING

- 1. What does your school do to make students feel welcome and encourage them to get involved?
- 2. What kinds of clubs and organizations are available? What social activities are available in the surrounding community?
- 3. What opportunities are available for leadership experiences?
- 4. Among extracurricular organizations at the college, which seem to be the most active, the most vital?
- 5. Please tell me about traditions the school has.
- 6. How extensive is Greek life on campus?
- 7. What do students typically do in their down time?
- 8. What kind of person would be happy on this campus? Unhappy?
- 9. What are the current issues of concern among the students?
- 10. Is it an activist or political student body?
- 11. How active and effective is student government?
- 12. What are the opportunities for participating in intercollegiate or intramural sports?
- 13. What type of housing is available to first-year students?
- 14. How are roommates chosen?

#### STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

- 1. What academic support services do you have available on campus (tutoring, writing center, etc.)? Is there a fee?
- 2. Do you have counseling services on campus? Is there a fee?
- 3. Where are the student services department located?
- 4. Is there a writing center to help with student essays?
- 5. Is tutoring available?
- 6. Do you have a learning community or other freshman experience to aid in the transition to college?

## TRANSPORTATION

- 1. Can I have a car on campus, and how convenient is parking?
- 2. What does parking cost?
- 3. How far is the campus from an airport or train station?

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

- 1. Is there a fitness or recreational center on or near campus?
- 2. How is the student health program organized?
- 3. How far away is the nearest fully equipped hospital?
- 4. What is the campus crime rate?
- 5. What does campus security consist of?
- 6. What is the most frequently reported on-campus crime?
- 7. Have there been any serious incidents of on-campus crime in recent years?

## TO ASK CURRENT STUDENTS

- 1. What do you love most about the school and what is something you'd change?
- 2. How many hours a week do you study? Is that typical here?
- 3. Are faculty members interested in students and accessible outside of class?
- 4. Do many students go home on weekends?

- 5. What are the dorms like?
- 6. Will I be living in a single, double, or triple room?
- 7. Are the dorms wired for the Internet?
- 8. Are the athletic facilities open to all students or only to athletes?
- 9. Is it possible to study in your dorm room?
- 10. Is the food good?
- 11. Are campus jobs readily available?
- 12. Is there easy access to computers? Where are they located?
- 13. What's the library like as a place to study or to do research?
- 14. How easy is it to get the classes you want?
- 15. To what extent is there interaction between faculty and students?
- 16. Do you use any of the support services (career center, counseling center, writing center, etc.). Are they helpful?
